It is because of all who are involved that we can support God's work around the world through MCC and keep our prices low to be a ministry in this community.

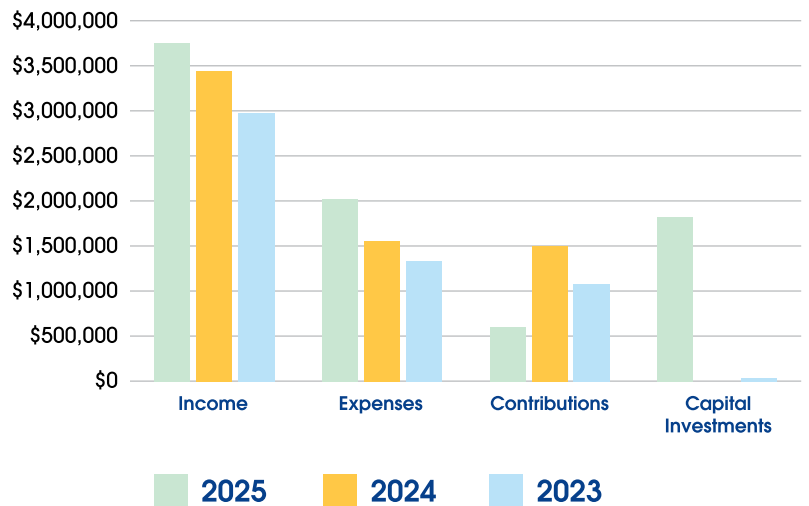
